Roadmap (Tentative Plan for Eight Semesters)

Instructions:

1. This plan is designed for eight semesters, starting Fall.
2. All the courses which are required for a Major in English are in bold.
3. All the courses in English which are required for the completion of General Education requirements are underlined.
4. Electives not listed in the roadmap will also be offered
5. All students must fulfill the requirements of General Education course ENGL 101 and ENGL 103 for registering for 200 level - 400 level courses.
6. The following courses are offered every semester:
 - ENGL 101 (Basic Writing Skills) 30 section in Spring and 10 sections in Fall
 - ENGL103 (Advanced Writing Skills) 10 sections in Spring and 30 sections in Fall
 - ENGL201 (Introduction to Literature) 2 Section in Spring and 2 sections in Fall
 - ENGL217 (Introduction to Linguistics) 1 section in Spring and 1 section in Fall
 - ENGL331 (Research Methods) 1 Section in Spring and 1 section in Fall
 - ENGL499 (Independent Research) 1 Section each in Spring, Fall and Summer.

Note: ENGL 250: Creative Writing will be offered in Summer only. Other electives offered in Summer can vary.
