To motivate advisees to:

- find out opportunities of higher education in their respective field of study
- learn about CV development
- do degree audit
- enhance their complimentary skills (elective area of study)
- prepare for tests such as GRE, TOEFL, IELTS, etc. according to their needs
- encourage them to attend the "Job Fair/Education Expo" so that they may know about career as well as higher education opportunities and look for appropriate placements

Junior year

To encourage advisees to:

- make roadmaps of their Major area of study
- attend "Orientation for Major Students" in order to know about the requirements of their respective Major (core courses, prerequisites, specializations, etc.)
- discuss the scope of their Major
- plan their career according to their respective Major
- learn about the opportunities of higher education in their chosen field
- meet the requirements of their Major for timely completion of their degrees
- enhance their complimentary skills (elective areas of study)
- develop the plan for double Major/Minor (if any)
- do an initial degree audit
- comply with the relevant catalog

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To help advisees to:

- make and develop well defined academic plans, General Education plan/record,
 8 semester plan and career planning
- maintain CGPA not less than 2.5 or above
- engage in community services and in events arranged by different societies
- declare their Major well in time
- help advisees in developing their aptitude and decide major accordingly and to explore higher education and career opportunities as well

Sophomore year

To integrate advisees to university life and help them understand the:

- semester system/LAE
