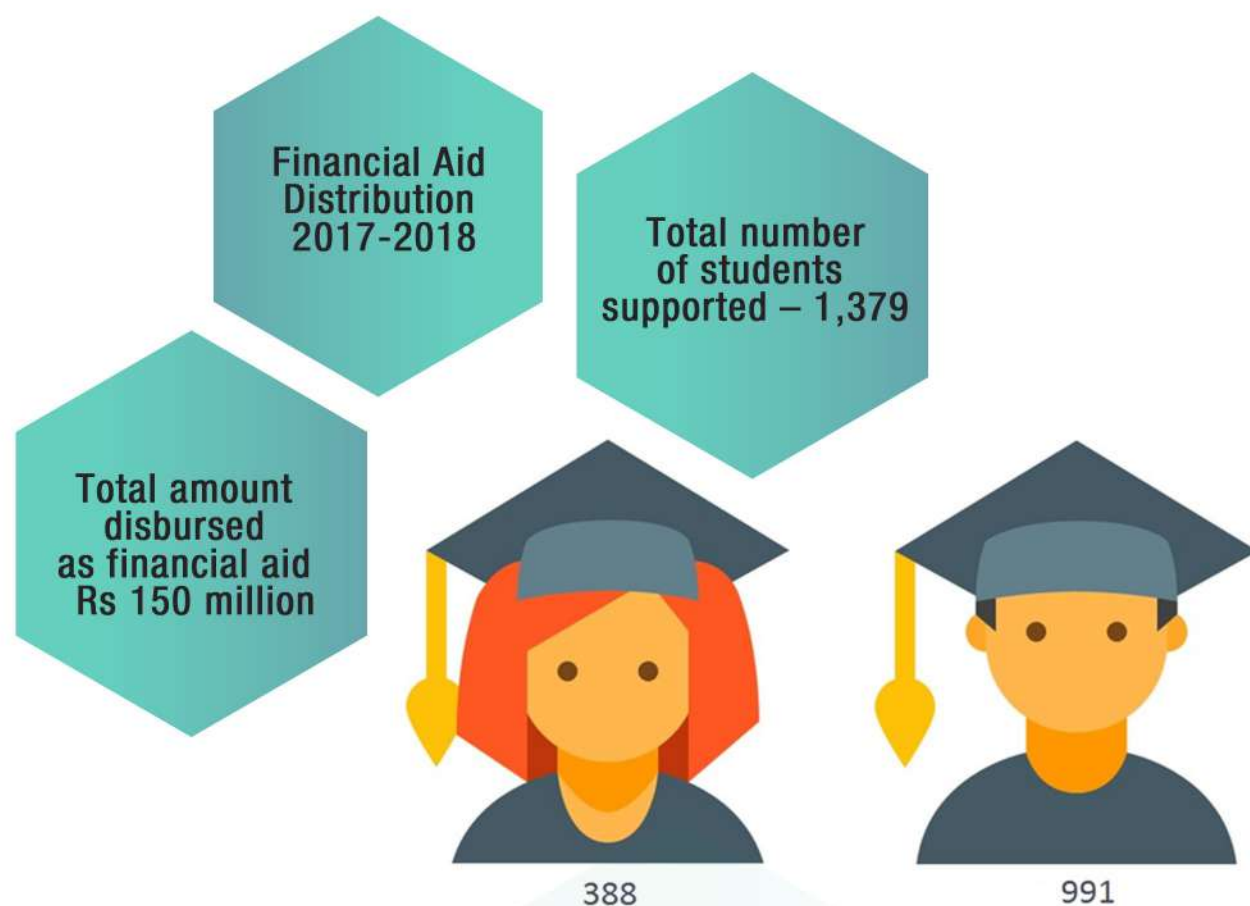

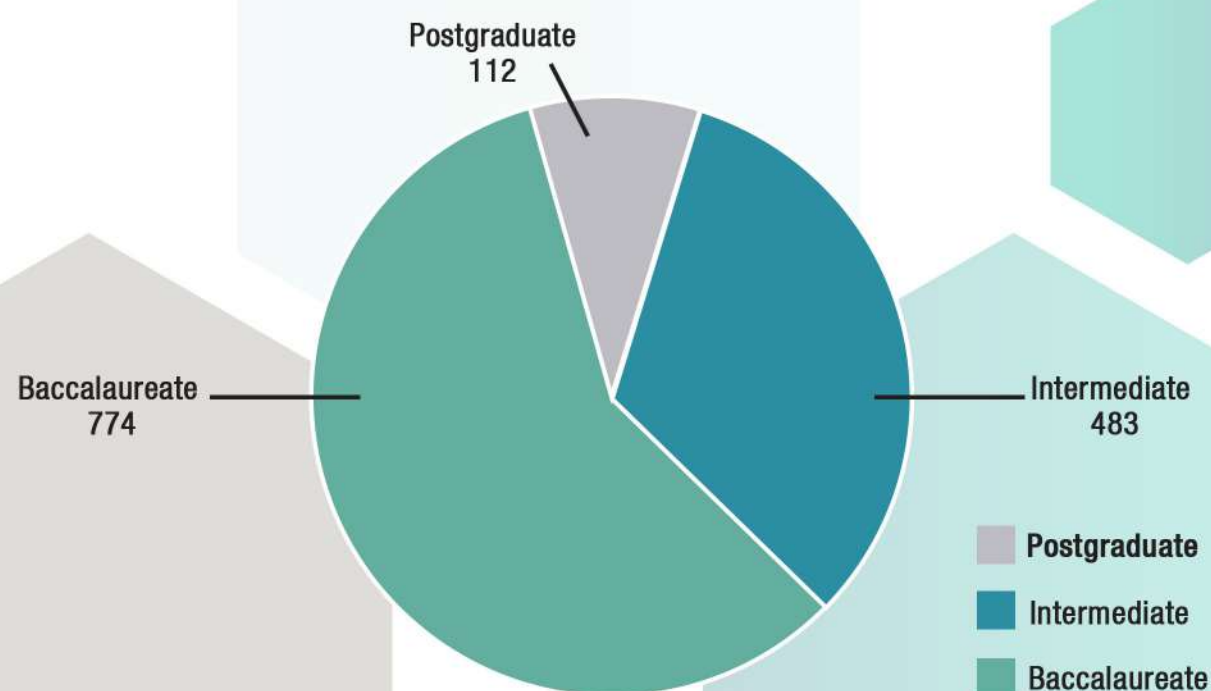

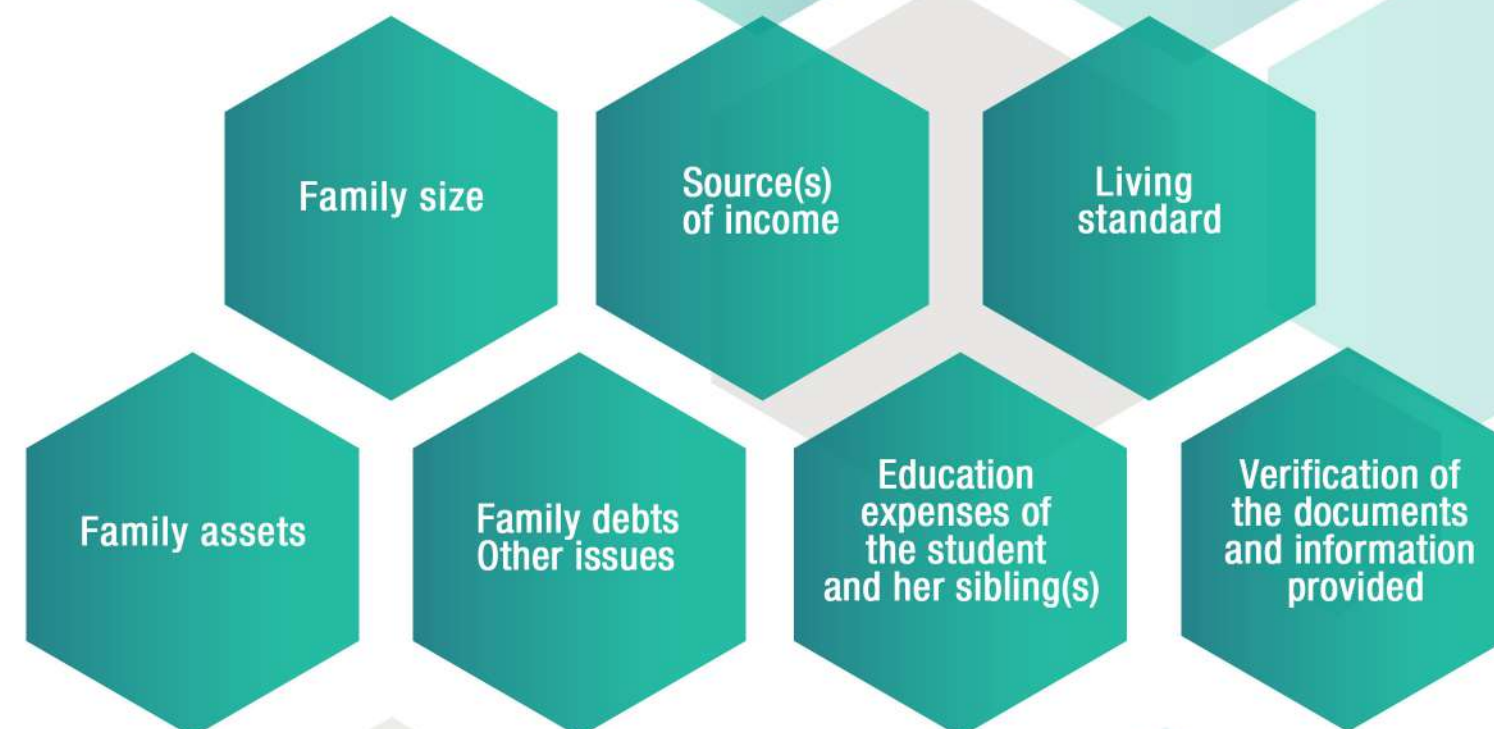
Program-Wise Distribution of Financial Aid
