- All courses must be of 3 credit hours or above.
- Two Science courses must be of 4 credits with labs.
- Exemptions and Credits: MCOM100, URDU101, MATH100 can be exempted on the basis of Competency Exam at FCCU during Freshmen Year. (Please see details in your catalog.)
- A-Level Based Credits: please see details in your Catalog.
- It is advised not to repeat the course(s) which are transferred or qualify for credits on the basis of A-Level Exam.
- Courses taken for Major will also count towards the requirements of General Education in that category. The credits will be counted towards Major.
