Requirements for Minor in Sociology

18 credit hours (six courses) which must include SOCL 100 and SOCL 201. At least two courses need to be at the 300/400 level.

Requirements for a B.A. (Hons) in Sociology

36 credit hours (twelve courses) including SOCL 100, SOCL 201, SOCL 301, SOCL 494 and 499. At least six Sociology courses need to be at the 300/400 level.

Requirements for the B.S. (Hons) in Sociology

48 credit hours which must include SOCL 100, 201, 223, 301, 325, 350, 494, and 499. At least six Sociology courses must be at the 300/400 level
